

LAST WILL AND TESTAMENT

of

TATIANA TRUHEART

I, TATIANA TRUHEART, an adult resident citizen of County, LOUDOUN COUNTY, VIRGINIA, being of sound and disposing mind, memory and understanding, do hereby make, publish, and declare this my Last Will and Testament, and I do hereby revoke any and all prior wills and codicils heretofore made by me.

I am married to my HUSBAND, DIEGO ALEXANDER TRUHEART. I have THREE children at the time of making this Will. They are DAUGHTER, VALENTINA TATIANA TRUHEART, AGE FOUR, SON, ALEXANDER DIEGO TRUHEART, AGE SEVEN, AND SON, DONOVAN FREDERICO TRUEHEART, AGE TEN.

ARTICLE I

PAYMENT OF FINAL EXPENSES, TAXES AN DEBTS

I hereby direct my Executor to pay all expenses of my last illness, funeral, burial, and administration of my estate and all of my just debts which may be probated, registered, and allowed against my estate, and the administration of my estate be paid out of my residuary estate and without the necessity of prior Court approval, as soon as may conveniently be done.

ARTICLE III

DISTRIBUTION OF TANGIBLE PERSONAL PROPERTY

A. Memorandum of Distribution. I may leave a memorandum or list, signed by me, with this Last Will and Testament directing the disposition of certain items of my tangible personal

property. Any such memorandum or list Last Will and Testament Page 2 of 5 is incorporated in this Will by this reference in accordance with Section 64.2-_____ of the Code of Virginia (1950), as amended. If such a memorandum or list is found, I ask my Executor to abide by it. If such a memorandum or list is not found within thirty (30) days of my Executor's qualification on my estate, it should be presumed that no such list exists.

B. Distribution of Remaining Tangible Personal Property. To the extent items of my tangible personal property are not otherwise specifically and effectively bequeathed herein or in such memorandum or list made by me, my Executor shall distribute in kind items of my tangible personal property to my _____, if _____ survives me, or if _____ does not survive me, to my _____, _____, _____ and _____ in shares as equal as reasonably possible, per stirpes . Any items not distributed in kind shall be sold and the net proceeds added to my residuary estate. Any remaining items shall be donated to charity or disposed of as my Executor deems appropriate.

C. Distribution to Minor Beneficiary. The receipt of the custodian of the person of any minor child beneficiary shall constitute a full acquittance to my Executor as regards such beneficiary child's share of this bequest, and such custodian shall not be required to give bond or qualify as guardian in any Court for this purpose.

D. Packing and Shipping. I direct that all the costs of packing, shipping, insurance, and other charges incident to the distribution of any tangible personal property herein, shall be paid by my Executor out of the principal of Last Will and Testament Page 3 of 5 my residuary estate with no right of reimbursement from any recipient of any such property.

ARTICLE IV

DISTRIBUTION OF RESIDUE OF ESTATE

A. I give the residue of my real and personal property, of every kind and wherever situated, that I own at my death or to which I may be entitled at my death to survives me.

B. If _____ does not survive me, I give my residuary estate to _____, _____, _____, and _____, in equal shares, per stirpes.

ARTICLE V
APPOINTMENT OF GUARDIAN OF MINOR CHILDREN

If at the time of my death, any of my children are under the age of eighteen (18) years and my spouse does not survive me, I hereby nominate and appoint _____ of _____ as Guardian of the person and property of my minor child(ren). It is my desire that the Guardian shall have personal custody of my minor child(ren). Last Will and Testament Page 4 of 5 I direct that the Guardian appointed shall serve without bond or sureties in this or any other jurisdiction.

ARTICLE VI
APPOINTMENT OF EXECUTOR

I nominate and appoint _____, Executor of this, my Last Will and Testament. In the event he is unable or unwilling to serve, I nominate and appoint _____, as successor Executrix. I direct that my Executor and any successor be permitted to serve without bond and that if, notwithstanding this request, any bond is required by law, statute, or rule of Court, no sureties be required thereon so far as the law may permit.

ARTICLE VII FIDUCIARY POWERS
Fiduciary Powers.

My Executor or his successor shall have full discretionary power to do whatever is necessary for the full administration of my estate. My Executor shall be entitled to reimbursement for all reasonable costs and expenses actually incurred and paid by my Executor on behalf of my estate under this Last Will and Testament. My Executor shall be entitled to compensation in a sum of five percent (5%) of the gross inventory value of my estate for services rendered as Executor under this Last Will and Testament.

ARTICLE VIII
GENERAL PROVISIONS

- A. Whenever it is provided herein that any person shall benefit if such person shall survive me, that person shall be deemed not to have survived me if he or she shall die within fourteen (14) days after my death.
- B. Where appropriate to the context, pronouns or other terms expressed in one number and gender shall be deemed to include the other number and gender.
