




## "Personal Representative:

A term used to mean either the executor or the administrator of the decedent's estate. This term only applies to the person administering a testate (having a will) or intestate (not having a will) estate and does not apply to any other type of fiduciary.""

**Slide 5: VA Code** : § 64.2-508. Within 30 days after the date of qualification or admission of the will to probate, a personal representative or proponent of the will shall forward notice by delivery or by first-class mail, postage prepaid, to the persons entitled to notice at their last known address.
